1. Slim Jim

A slim jim can open the car door without having a key. Locksmiths employ this tool because it is easy to use and lets them unlock a variety of cars in a short time. However, this method can cause damage to your vehicle if not used properly. It is essential to talk with an expert for advice on how to avoid damaging your vehicle.

The slim jim is a metal strip with a notch at one end. It is placed between the window and the weather stripping to secure to the rods that connect to the locking mechanisms. The locksmith can unlock the vehicle without taking out the window. In some cases it could be quicker than using a key or lockpick.

This tool is employed not only by professionals who work in lock repair, but also by opportunists who want to take over cars. It could be a successful attack, or cause the thief's lock to become inoperable. Modern locks are designed to withstand this type of attack.
