Mesothelioma

Mesothelioma is a kind of cancer that affects the thin layer of tissue that surrounds organs within the body. It is usually caused by exposure to asbestos, which is a substance that is used in a variety of industrial applications. Asbestos-related victims could be entitled to compensation from the companies that exposed them to this dangerous substance. Mesothelioma typically develops in the layers of tissue that surround each lung (the pleura). It may also start in the peritoneum, the thick membrane that surrounds stomach organs. Mesothelioma symptoms include chest or stomach pain, difficulty breathing and fever, as well as coughing. The disease is typically diagnosed by a physician who conducts a physical exam and records the patient's medical history. A patient's doctor may also order a chest X-ray or CT scan to check for signs of mesothelioma, like lung inflammation and scarring called plaques in the pleural region.

Asbestos victims who have been diagnosed with mesothelioma, or another asbestos-related disease are entitled to receive financial compensation for their current, past and future medical expenses, loss of income, and emotional suffering. Compensation from mesothelioma lawsuits can help families cover funeral expenses, travel expenses, and treatment costs.

Asbestos Exposure in Military Bases

Army bases tended to have less asbestos than Navy and Air Force bases, but there were many exposure opportunities for soldiers. Army bases were asbestos-free in the roofing, flooring, and cement used in their buildings. Asbestos was also found in bedding, and in the insulation of ceilings, walls and brakes, clutch plates and gaskets for vehicles. Infantrymen in the Army were at a greater risk of exposure because they frequently worked in motor pools repairing and maintaining transport vehicles of every kind.

It is also true that members of the Merchant Marine transported cargo and passengers in peacetime and during the war. Asbestos was present on their ships in boiler rooms, steam lines, pipes heaters, valves, and gaskets. Merchant Marine workers were also exposed to asbestos while they took apart and repaired vehicles from the armed forces.

The three branches of the military have employed asbestos from the 1930s until the 1970s. The Navy, Air Force, and Army all used asbestos in their bases, as well as on their aircrafts and ships.

Veterans Affairs can pay compensation to asbestos patients diagnosed with mesothelioma or asbestosis. Compensation may include disability benefits and healthcare, as also compensation for lost wages.

Asbestos-related victims must prove their case by providing evidence of their military service and medical records.
